## FINAL DECREE

In this Chapter 11 bankruptcy case, the Debtor-in-Possession ("Debtor") filed its Second Amended Joint Plan of Reorganization ("Plan") on March 5, 2015 [Doc. No. 473], and the Court, after notice and hearing, entered an Order Confirming Second Amended Joint Plan ("Order") on March 5, 2015 [Doc. No. 475], and no appeal or notice of appeal having been filed; and the Debtor having filed a Motion for Final Decree in this case on July 22, 2015, which the Court routinely grants or denies without notice or hearing with the right to request a hearing under Montana Local Bankruptcy Rule 9013-1(g)(2)(AA), and no objection thereto and request for hearing having been filed, and it having been determined by the Court, based upon the whole record herein that:

1. The transfer or other disposition of all substantially all of the property dealt with by the Plan pursuant to the provisions of the Plan has occurred;

2. The reorganized Debtor as defined in the Plan has assumed the operations of or the management of substantially all of the property dealt with by the Plan; and,

3. The reorganized Debtor has distributed to creditors affected by the Plan the cash as specified in the Plan. Accordingly,

## **IT IS ORDERED:**

1. Debtor's Motion for Final Decree filed July 22, 2015 (Doc. No. 546) is GRANTED;

2. That Debtor is released from all dischargeable debts and liabilities, except as provided in the Plan and Order;

3. The Plan has been substantially consummated; and,

4. This Chapter 11 case and Estate are hereby **CLOSED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED under Mont. LBR 9013-1(g)(2)(AA) any party in interest has the right to object, request a hearing and schedule a hearing to reconsider this Final Decree within fourteen (14) days of the date of this Final Decree.
