Greetings,

Junior High Rally has gathered young people annually for over a decade for the dual purposes of growing in faith and connecting with other Catholic young people. You and your young people are invited to join in this legacy!

In late August, the Catholic Youth Coalition Board prayerfully discerned our theme for this year: "Humble Unto Obedience." Please pray for us as we work hard to develop activities, talks, and sessions around this theme.

This event is designed to inspire 6-8th graders in their faith. The emphasis is on evangelization (even *pre*-evangelization) and friendship building. While we will certainly be providing catechesis, the emphasis of the event is on inspiring young people in their faith. We invite adult chaperones to embrace this vision by bringing your enthusiasm, joy, and laughter.

Events like Junior High Rally serve as an opportunity for parishes to literally and figuratively accompany young people in their faith. Youth Ministers, Chaperones, & Adult Volunteers

Junior High Rally happens because of your commitment to accompany youth in their walk with the Lord. Thank you.

Dress Code & Behavior:

Communicate clearly to youth, parents, and adult chaperones your expectations for dress and behavior. Youth and adults are urged to dress casually and to wear comfortable, appropriate clothing for a very active day! All participants must wear their designated nametag.

Diocesan staff will assist in whatever way we can, but the primary responsibility lays with the youth minister/adult chaperones at all times! If problems arise that cannont be satisfactorily resolved, OYYAM staff reserves the right to send participants home early at the expense of the individual involved.

If a situation arises that requires adult supervision of any young person, take charge of anything in the area deemed needful.

Remember that we all represent the Church. Please present a positive image by your actions and words. Rally is a tobacco and drug free event (for everyone). Chaperones are expected to refrain from all alcohol, tobacco and/or drug use.

Pay close attention to the needs and behavior of those entrusted to your care. During any "free" time, you are expected to know the whereabouts of your youth! We expect that you yourself not go anywhere that you could or would not take your youth with you. You are a role model for these youth.

We strongly suggest that you give emergency contact info for each of your youth to all of your adult chaperones.

Registration:

Participants must register BEFORE the event through their local parish/school. There will be no onsite registration.

Gather the completed registration form (see attached) and fee from each participant – both youth and adult chaperones. Then, the designated adult from the parish or school must submit the registration online at diocesehelena.org/juniorhighrally.

Do not send paper forms to Diocese.

Payment:

The cost of attendance for both youth and adult chaperones is \$55. (This includes lunch & thsirt.) For a donation (suggested \$5 per person) you can also have dinner at the Cathedral. (see details on p. 5.) You may submit payment online when you register or send/bring a check.

CYC Board youth do NOT need to pay to attend Rally, but they must register in advance. They must also be chaperoned by an adult.



Food:

Lunch and snacks are included in the cost of the event. Dinner is available for a suggested donation of \$5 per person. See details on p. 5

Housing:

If a group requires housing , they are responsible for making their own arrangements.

Safe Environment:

All adults (18+) must meet the safe environment requirements of their respective diocese/church.

Youth-to-Chaperone Ratio is 10:1.

Transportation:

Youth should not drive themselves or other youth to any OYYAM event. All participants are discouraged from using their vehicles during the weekend other than for immediate, Rally-related transportation. Groups using commercial transportation or drivers who will not stay through the day should make plans for transportation in an emergency.

It is the responsibility of participant groups to secure the necessary permissions and addressing related liability concerns.

Code of Conduct, Medical Consent & Media Release

PARTICIPANT CONDUCT, MEDICAL CONSENT, & MEDIA RELEASE STATEMENTS

I, the undersigned, hereby grant permission for me/my child (Participant) to participate in the 2023 Junior High Rally (Rally) scheduled for Saturday, October 28, at Carroll College in Helena, MT, which may require transportation away from my home church. As a legal adult myself or the parent/legal guardian of Participant, I remain legally responsible for any personal actions taken by Participant. I agree on behalf of myself/my child, or our heirs, successors, and assigns, to hold harmless and defend my parish/school and the Roman Catholic Bishop of Helena, Diocese of Helena (Diocese), Carroll College, adult chaperones, and representatives associated with Rally, arising from or in connection with me/my child attending Rally or in connection with any illness, injury or cost of medical treatment in connection therewith, and I agree to compensate the parish, its directors and agents, and the Diocese, chaperones or its representatives for reasonable attorney's fees and expenses arising in connection therewith.

I hereby warrant that to the best of my knowledge, I/my child is in good health, and I assume all responsibility for the health of me/my child. In the event of an emergency, I hereby give permission to transport me/my child to a hospital for emergency medical or surgical treatment. I wish to be advised prior to any further treatment by the hospital/doctor.

I/my child agrees to abide by all rules attached to Rally. Specific behaviors that are not permitted include, but are not limited to: fighting, obscene language, offensive or revealing clothing, and the use/possession of tobacco, vaping products, alcohol, illegal drugs, and weapons. I also understand that if Participant violates any of the rules, Participant may be required to leave the activity at his/her own expense.

Event directors have the authority to prohibit video camera or other forms of image-recording devices, as appropriate, to prevent distractions or to protect against violating the privacy of participants. Violation of this policy may result in confiscation of such equipment for the duration of Rally and/or dismissal from the event.

By signing this form I understand that a picture of myself/my child and/or work or projects created by myself/my child (e.g. still pictures, audio/video recording, etc.) may be published in print or online by my parish, school, Legendary Lodge, Diocese, The Foundation for the Diocese of Helena, Carroll College, or their agents to advance the mission and purpose of the Catholic Church. I also grant Diocese permission to share the information on this registration form with these or other entities to advance the mission and purpose of the Catholic Church.
