Cost (Adults & Youth)

Registration (includes housing): \$675 Travel (estimated): \$650

Total Per Person: \$1,325

Deadlines

\$325 (1st Installment) Due: August 1 \$350 (2nd Installment) Due: October 1

Details

Registration: Cost includes 4 nights hotel (4 people per room/suite), NCYC registration fee, 4 meals, and OYYAM apparel.

Travel: Transportation to/from Indianapolis will be managed by your local parish youth minister/group leader. Costs will vary depending on your choice of flight schedule.

Food: Only 4 meals are covered with registration. Participants should bring money to cover meals/snacks. (Suggested \$25 per day.)

Chaperones: Youth must attend with an adult (21+) chaperone who meets Safe Environment (VIRTUS) requirements (e.g. parish youth minister).

About NCYC

NCYC (National Catholic Youth Conference) is a powerfully unique three-day experience of prayer, community, evangelization, catechesis, service, and empowerment for Catholic teenagers (Grades 9-12) and their adult chaperones. NCYC is the premier Catholic youth event on a national scale that gathers people from all across America for a life-changing encounter with Christ.

The schedule includes keynote addresses, prayer, workshops, liturgy, reconciliation, exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, recreational activities, concerts, exhibits and an interactive thematic park.

The 2025 theme, "I Am | Yo Soy," will reflect on the time God appeared to Moses through the burning bush and explore how the Sacraments are the living story of God's love, uniting us with Him through Jesus and the Church. Through the Sacraments, we encounter the fullness of salvation and the tangible presence of Immanuel—God with us.

How do I sign Up?

Youth (Grades 9-12)

NCYC is a community experience. Youth *must* register through their local parish or school and ensure that an adult chaperone will journey with them to Indianapolis.

Connect with your local youth minister or the designated "Parish/School Group Leader" (see below) to get more information.

Young Adults (18-20)

Those who have graduated high school AND are 18-20 may participate in NCYC as an assistant chaperone with a parish/school group. You must meet diocesan Safe Environment policies (VIRTUS).

Parish/School Group Leaders ("Youth Minister")

Our Diocese of Helena NCYC pilgrimage is meant to be experienced with a local faith community (e.g. a parish or a school). If you are interested in being a Group Leader, please contact Kevin Molm: kmolm@dohmt.org or 406.389.7055.

Group Leader Responsibilities/Expectations:

- 21+ & Safe Environment (VIRTUS) certified
- Register with 1st installment by Aug. 1
- Manage registrations for your group
- Ensure youth have designated chaperone
- Assist with coordinating fund raising efforts for your group
- Communication liaison between OYYAM & your group
- Facilitate pilgrimage and prayer experiences for your group
